Cinta Gallent Torres is an associate professor at *Universitat de València* and *Universidad Internacional de Valencia* in Spain. With a PhD in Education and a double degree in Translation and Interpreting and French, she was a teaching assistant and researcher in the Modern and Classical Languages Department of the University of Connecticut (USA), where she studied her Master of Arts in Spanish. In 2005, she was nominated *Outstanding Graduate Teaching Assistant* by this university and, in 2018, she was nominated *Mejor Profesor de España 2018* for the Educa Abanca Awards.

Along with teaching French, she tutors students carrying out their final studies in the master's degree in Teacher Training and the *master's degree in Bilingual Education*. Her research areas are the evaluation of university professors, cyber-plagiarism and academic misconduct. She has published scientific articles on the latter topic and, in 2018, she joined the International Institute for Research and Action on Academic Fraud and Plagiarism (Geneva).
