A specialist in the Canary Islands and the Western Maghreb, his current research include, among other topics, the landscapes and built spaces, the dynamics of colonization and acculturation, ethnoarchaeology and the theory of material culture, and, finally, "public" archaeology and heritage management of archaeological sites.

Between 2006 and 2010, he was a member of the Board of the University Quality Agency of the Castilla-La Mancha region.
