Marian Popescu has been teaching in the Higher Education since 1991 creating new courses in the Performing Arts (Theatre) domain curriculum and worked with students-actors, theatre directors, and dancers. He also taught at the Faculty of Letters in Bucharest, the Centre of Excellence in the Study of Image, and the universities in Bucharest and Cluj-Napoca. He has been elected president of the Ethics Committee of the University of Bucharest (2012-2014) and nominated as Romania's representative at the Council of Europe's ETINED (2016-2017, 2020). For his courageous involvement in the academic ethics, he received the prestigious "2015 Award of the Group for Social Dialogue". He is director of CARFIA (Center for Action, Resources, and Training for Academic Integrity).

He is author of seven books on Theatre and Performing Arts Culture and contributed to journals in Romania, Croatia, Slovenia, Hungary, Spain, United States with articles on Drama, Theatre, Performing Arts discourse, English and Romanian literatures.
