Michel Kalika is Emeritus Professor at Jean Moulin University, iaelyon School of Management in France. He is the director of the BSIS (Business School Impact System) assessment tool that he developed for the FNEGE (French Foundation for Management Education) and the EFMD (European Foundation for Management Development). He is also President of Business Science Institute, an international networked academic organisation that runs an Executive Doctorate in Business Administration (DBA) programme for management participants from across nearly 50 countries. He was previously Director of EM Strasbourg Business School and a member of faculty at the University of Paris Dauphine for over a decade. Michel Kalika is the author or co-author of more than 25 books (including *Management Stratégique*, the most frequently re-edited French publication written in this field) and of more than 100 other academic and practice-oriented publications in Strategy and Information Systems. His current research explores the concept of information overload ("Millefeuille" theory) and the impact of management schools on their wider environment.
