Dr. Sanja Peković has a Ph. D. in Economics from the University Paris-Est. She previously obtained a Master's degree from the École Nationale Des Ponts et Chaussées and University of Paris-Est Marne-la-Vallée. She is Associate Professor at the Faculty of Tourism and Hotel Management of the University of Montenegro (UoM). Since 2017, she is Director of the Centre for Quality Assurance of UoM and acting director of the Centre for research and innovation. She is a member of the University Senate as well as Vice-President of National Technology Park Board of Directors. Dr. Peković was visiting scholar at INRA / Montpellier SupAgro (France), at the University of Montenegro (Podgorica), at the Laboratoire franco-russe Poncelet CNRS UMI 2615 (Moscow), at the UCLA Institute of the Environment and Sustainability (Los Angeles).

Her research interests and publications are within the field of quality and environmental economics, economics of innovation, applied econometrics, academic integrity. She is also involved in several projects funded by national and international organizations (e.g. Heric, IPA, COST, etc.). Dr. Peković is a member of Steering Board of the Action "Quality Education for All (Quality ED – Montenegro)" under the European Union/ Council of Europe "Horizontal Facility for the Western Balkans and Turkey - Phase II". She was president of the working group for the "Certification of academic integrity for an institution" awarded by the IRAFPA to the UoM in 2019.
