

Jacques Py
Professor of Social Psychology
University of Toulouse (France)

Jacques Py is Professor of social psychology at the University of Toulouse (France). He is President of the Ethics Committee of Toulouse and was also a member of National Council of Universities - France. He was in charge of scientific integrity at his university. He is also a magistrate for the appeal of disciplinary cases in French universities.

He previously held a position at University Paris 8 where he managed the social psychology Laboratory. He was President elect of the French psychological Society (Société Française de Psychologie), and General Secretary of the National French Committee of scientific Psychology in association with Academy of Sciences.

Since 2007, he is Chief Editor of the European Review of Applied Psychology.

His research focuses on the knowledge that individuals have about social norms and in the field of cognitive and social psychology of eyewitness testimony aiming at building interview protocols for justice professionals. He has directed 19 Ph. D.
