Ludovic Jeanne holds a Ph. D. in Human, Economic and Regional Geography (University of Caen Normandie, 2002). He specializes in the analysis of territorial strategies and the territorialized interplays of actors at all scales. His works aims mainly at contributing to critical geopolitics of globalization and, for the most recent ones, at examining the heuristic value of a geoethical approach of territorial economic intelligence practices.

In addition to his research activity, he has had since 2010 a sustained activity of territorial intervention, including the editorial responsibility of the *Lettres d'Intelligence Economique et Territoriale*, and more recently of the *Regional Intelligence Notes: Regional Development Strategy* of the EM Normandie Business School. He is co-supervising two Ph. D. theses in this field.

In 2019, he became the Academic Integrity Officer, reporting to the Dean of Faculty and Research of the School. His main goal is to make academic integrity a common culture leading to better shared and articulated practices.

Certified as an "Integrity Advisor" by the IRAFPA in 2021, he is now committed to the common research effort in academic integrity. In this area, his work focuses mainly on the prospective of academic fraud in the light of emerging technologies, but also on the relevance of the interactionist approach regarding the prevention and fight against academic fraud.
