Michelle Bergadaà is Professor Emeritus of the University of Geneva. After her MBA, she obtained a Ph. D. from the joint program of the Universities of Montreal. She published more than 150 articles (with double-blind review process) in her field before devoting herself to integrity sciences. In 2004, she creates the collaborative website on plagiarism "responsable.unige.ch", which still has more than 18'000 international subscribers. Her book *Le plagiat académique. Comprendre pour agir* (L'Harmattan, Paris), in 2015, is attracting the support of an academic community in search of methods and processes adapted to the challenges of the 21st century. Together with a group of motivated researchers, she creates the IRAFPA in 2016. In 2019, she receives the International Grand Prize for Pedagogical Innovation awarded by the CIDEGEF, the FNEGE and the Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie (AUF). In 2021, she was elected President of the Ethics Committee of the University of Pau and Pays de l'Adour (UPPA), France.

In 2020, she publishes *Le temps entre science et création* (Time between science and creation), in the collection "Major French-speaking authors" (EMS Editions), which retraces the thread of her epistemological commitments. She gives conferences at the international level in order to strengthen the integrity sciences movement. Thus, in 2021, the book *L'urgence de l'intégrité académique*, Dir. M. Bergadaà and P. Peixoto, Coll. Questions de société (EMS Editions), brings together 41 international authors.
